Sub:- Grant of conditional permission to Panchasheel Shikshan Prasarak Mandal's Homoeopathic Medical College, Khamgaon, Maharashtra for the academic year 2020-21 in existing BHMS course with intake capacity sixty (60) seats and PG Course in four (04) subjects namely Practice of Medicine, Organon, Repertory and Paediatrics with three (03) seats each– regd

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under Section 12C of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and regulations made thereunder and Ministry's policy for the academic year 2020-21, In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has examined the documents submitted by the college authority for the admissions for the academic year 2020-21 in 1-BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and PG Course in 05 subjects namely Practice of Medicine, Materia Medica, Organon, Repertory, Paediatrics with each 03 seats at "**Panchasheel Shikshan Prasarak Mandal's Homoeopathic Medical College, Khamgaon, Maharashtra**, and furnished recommendation vide its letter No. F. No. 15-8/2020-CCH (Visitation Matter)/3979 dated 03.12.2020 as under:-

"Recommended for allowing admission in 1-BHMS Course for the session 2020-21 with the intake capacity of only 60 seats due to shortage of teaching faculties, as 03 teachers considered ineligible due to discrepancies in their documents and availability of 10 guest faculties could not verify in absence of their acquittance & attendance roll.

The Committee also recommended for allowing admission in the M.D. (Hom) Course in the Dept. of Organon of Medicine, Practice of Medicine, Repertory & Pediatrics with 03 seats in each subject and no admission in Materia Medica Dept. during 2020-21 as 01 Prof. considered 'on paper teacher' due to discrepancies in their documents"

2. The college was granted an opportunity of hearing through Video-Conferencing to present their case on 31.12.2020. The college authority submitted their representation. On examination of the representation submitted during hearing, it has been observed that college is NOT fulfilling the minimum required criteria for granting permission for admission with intake capacity of 100 UG seats and PG admission in the department of Materia Medica.

3. Therefore, after considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to

CCH, and report of the designated Hearing Committee of this Ministry, **conditional permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to “Panchasheel Shikshan Prasarak Mandal's Homoeopathic Medical College, Khamgaon, Maharashtra” for continuing admissions in BHMS course during the academic year 2020-21 with intake capacity of sixty (60) seats only and PG Course in four (04) subjects namely Practice of Medicine, Organon of Medicine, Repertory and Paediatrics with three (03) seats each and denial of permission for admission in PG Course of Materia Medica.**

4. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of undergraduate seats and 15% of Post Graduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course and MD Course shall be treated as All India quota. The counselling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling Authority of State/ UT Government as designated by the Central Government vide letter F. No. L. 11011/02/2020-E- (1) dated 26.10.2020 for A.Y. 2020-21 and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counselling Authority of that State / UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**

5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.

6. The College shall comply with the provision for providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

7. Further, the College shall comply with the procedure to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16th January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2021-22.

8. The compliance of the full requirements of the HCC (MSR) Regulations 2013 made up to 31st December 2020 will be submitted by the College to the CCH which will be verified for considering permission for admission during the Academic Year 2021-22.

9. Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter.
